## BIBLE STUDY QUESTIONS

1. How did you see God at work in your life this week? Do you have any updates on things we've been praying for? How have you taken steps of obedience to God this week?
2. Read 2 Corinthians 9:6-7. Paul says that God loves a cheerful giver. Why do you think God cares about the attitude with which people give? Why isn't it enough to just give money, why does the manner in which we give matter?
3. Read 2 Corinthians 9:10-11. God doesn't need your money; He is the one who supplies our every need. How does this reality change the way you think about giving? Why would God want us to give if He doesn't need our money?
4. The goal of giving is not only to meet material needs. Giving is also meant to glorify God. In which ways does giving bring glory to God? How have you seen this play out in real life?
5. How do you feel called to respond to this week's text and sermon? What steps of obedience do you feel the Spirit is calling you to take this week?

We want to live with the end in mind. We want to live with God-given purpose in light of eternity. One of our biggest mental strongholds preventing us from living with the end in mind is our relationship with money. What God intended to be a blessing in our lives, can become something that binds us. Money can be enthroned in our hearts as the god that provides security, freedom, power, and status.

When we, as disciples of Jesus, invest time and money in caring for a person or a project, what is our expectation? Which principles guide our thinking? In other words, do we live with an “end in mind” mindset?

Biblical giving principles that enable us to live with the end in mind:

1. **God** is the source of the giving and of the harvest, not **us**
2. We give cheerfully, because **God does**, not because **we have to**
3. We give out of God's **abundance** mindset, not a **scarcity** mindset
4. We give for **God's** glory and praise, not **ours**
