1. Prayer is a response to **the Father's** invitation to **intimate conversation**
2. Prayer to the Father is not an **impersonal, mechanical, boring** exercise
3. Prayer to the Father is, first and foremost, for **His loving agenda** to be done
4. Our Father **cares deeply** about our needs for **provision, welfare,** and **protection**
5. As disciples of Jesus, we pray because **every** day is **the Father's day!**
