Anxiety is pervasive in our society. Everyone experiences anxiety at some level. About 12% of the Canadian population will suffer from an anxiety disorder according to the Anxiety Disorders Association of Canada. That's one of the reasons why the song written by Bobby McFerrin, "Don't Worry, Be Happy", was such a hit! What does Jesus have to say about anxiety?

1. The **clear** command (v. 25, 31, 34): Do not be **anxious!**
2. The **fundamental** question (v.26-30): **Whom** do you **trust?**
3. The **heart** of the matter (v. 31-33): What are you **running after?**
4. **Common** sense (v. 34): Isn't **one day** at a time **enough?**
